## Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

In Hungary the Final Debate Contest was organized in Budapest on 30.05.2023. in presence in Hungary with the support of HBAID staff, selected debate judges and accompanied teachers. Groups of 6 students were asked to debate about pro and cons of a selected topic (see below). Participants arrived from five different cities (Budapest, Pécs, Debrecen, Velence, Kisujszállás) to Budapest.

A total of 404 students and 47 teachers and helpers participated in the national debate contest according to the following breakdown: students - Female: 218, Male: 186, Non-binary: 0, total students: 404, Teachers- Female: 37, Male: 10 Non-binary: 0, total number of teachers: 47

Total number of participants: 404 +47=451

While a total of 98 participants attended on the final to the following breakdown: male 60, female 38,

Non-binary: 0. Students: 60 students and 38 teachers, helpers, organizers.

By May 10, the schools shared with us the nominated "winner" teams to the final of the debate competition which was held on May 30 at Budapest.

The thesis of the debate contest were formulated around EU and Green issues to deepen the knowledge of EU values and rights, climate change issues and also promote teamwork, research, public speaking, also to encourage young people to become active citizens and actors of positive change; to promote opportunities for young people to support their personal and professional development; draw inspiration from the actions, vision and insights of young people.

here are some of them: GREEN ISSUES

• "CLIMATE CHANGE MAY FURTHER DECREASE WATER AVAILABILITY IN EU MEMBER COUNTRIES, THEREFORE NATIONAL GOVERNMENTS SHOULD USE PRICING POLICIES TO CONTROL WATER CONSUMPTION."
