with the preparation by WeWorld of a package of information documents shared with the schools consisting of:

- Brief Debate to explain in a synthetic and clear way the methodology and the objectives of the
 debates.
- MoU for Debate template to provide a collaborative framework for agreements with schools.
- Debate Rules guidelines to explain the methodology used (Exponi le tue Idee), the rules of the
 debate, the timing and all the important indications for correctly participating in the debate contest.

Identification and initial contacts with schools started in September 2022 coinciding with the start of the new school year.

The Debate Papers were produced based on WeWorld experience and following WeWorld methodology to be used for school contest. They analyse a topic, illustrating the pro and con positions that the two teams must support with convincing arguments. The debate papers were produced with a multidisciplinary approach by analysing the issue of climate change in a transversal way. Issues related to education, cooperation, gender equality and human rights were also included (WP2_Topic_Debate Papers).

In December 2022, 4 local meetings were organized in which a total of 52 teachers and other relevant stakeholders of the educational community participated (school principals, educators, student representatives, representatives of local associations).

The decision to hold more than 1 meeting represented an opportunity to reach a larger number of schools and teachers interested in the presentation of the project and the methodology of the debate.

The 4 local meetings took place in 4 different Italian cities:

• Bergamo: 21st December 2022

• Pisa: 13th December 2022

San Lazzaro di Savena (Bologna): 14th December 2022

• Seregno (Monza-Brianza): 19th December 2022

Furthermore, at the "Istituto Tecnico Industriale Marconi" in Gorgonzola (Milan), in collaboration with the school, a fifth local meeting was held on 12th December 2022, which was attended by 8 other teachers from the school.

In total, therefore, 5 meetings were held with 60 participants (21 males and 39 females).

The meetings lasting about 2 hours were held in the afternoon to allow the participation of the greatest number of participants.

The objectives of the meeting were:

- Insight into the aims of the initiative;
- Deepening of the methodology of the debate and of the regulation of the initiative;
- Sharing of the process and methods of inclusion of the debate activity in the training curriculum in order to ensure the sustainability of the project.

Finally, during the meetings some topics to be discussed were selected and debate simulations were carried out in order to provide practical tools to be transmitted to colleagues and students.
