The purpose of these assessments is to provide the Chairman and the Board of Directors with an independent, objective assurance and consulting activity to add value and improve WeWorld operations.

The Internal Auditor shall perform audits in all locations of the organization, both at the HQ level and in the Countries of operation, depending on the approved audit plan, to review and evaluate the effectiveness and efficiency of operations, reliability of financial reporting, compliance with applicable local laws and regulations, financial reporting regulations and safeguarding of assets. The Internal Auditor is responsible for preparing reports of the results of the audits.
